




2 in 5 households in Lane County are cost burdened.

What is a cost-burdened household?







HOUSEHOLD INCOME AND POVERTY

The median household income in Lane County is \$42,931.

HOUSEHOLD INCOME DISPARITIES





20% of the population in Lane County falls below the poverty line.

When households spend over 30% of their household income on housing they may have difficulty affording other necessities like food and medical care.
